


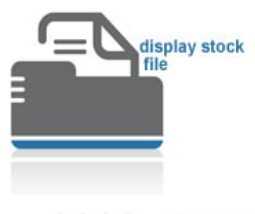

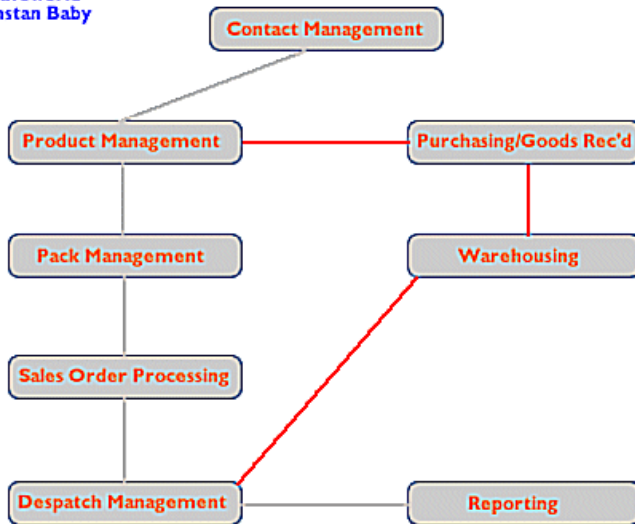

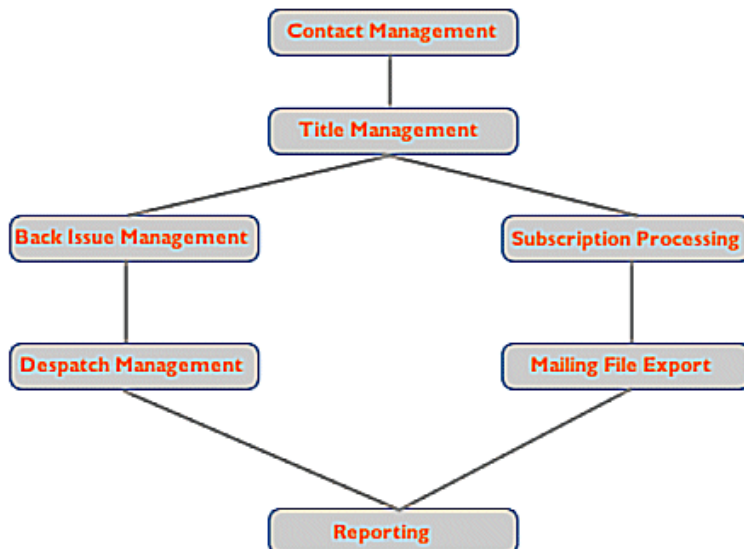

> CONTACT MANAGEMENT

Summary

Provide the facility for new and existing contacts to be managed through the system, along with data capture requirements and amendment auditing.

Requirement type

This module is the default module for all systems and is an absolute requirement.

> SUBSCRIPTION MANAGEMENT

Summary

This module allows BTB to manage customer subscriptions and renewals based accounts such as BHF and Northern & Shell.

Summary

> WEB BASED SERVICES

BTB Mailflight are able to offer clients various online services.

Scheduled web based reporting

This option is available for any client who purchases the reporting module but would like to view reports online on a daily basis.

The account is hosted within BTB Mailflight's domain and reports are scheduled to run and upload on a daily basis.

Realtime web based reporting

This option is available for any client who wishes to see up to the minute reporting figures online. The account is hosted on BTB Mailflight's secured webspace and packets of information are sent via webservices as each transaction occurs.

Data Capture

BTB Mailflight can design your data capture requirements into online forms that can then be accessed by customers/subscribers/contacts alike.

Client webpages will be hosted on our secured webspace and are skinned with your corporate design to allow seamless customer browsing.

Web Services

A variety of web services are available for clients connection. All web services are hosted on BTB Mailflight's secure webspace and are client unique. Our web services will allow clients to pass information from their own websites and systems to BTB Mailflight's for integration and order processing. All web services are subject to agreement and specification.

- **Receiving your order data**

We host fulfilment accounts on our secured web server which would give you access to a http post functionality which accepts xml content. As your orders are confirmed as ok to despatch (presumably after payment) you would then send an http post holding an agreed xml structure to the BTB Mailflight web server. We would read in this order, check everything is ok and then return a response i.e. 1=ok, 2=fail, 3=duplicate.

- **Sending you, or your customers, order confirmations**

These orders are then available for immediate despatch at our warehouse. At the point of despatch we have the facility to send your server a despatch feed with the following being the most used information:

- 1) Your order number
- 2) Our order number
- 3) Carrier service used
- 4) Tracking number

This information could then be imported to your systems for customer updates etc. We can also send a branded email to your customer letting them know that their order has been despatched if you required us to.

- **Updating your online stock system**

Our warehousing system updates the web based fulfilment account with any physical stock alterations (for whatever reason, adjustments/picks/returns.....) in real time. We then give access to another web service where you can post an xml packet and we return the stock level at any time you require.

> COLDFUSION DATA SHEET

Server Monitor

ColdFusion 8 introduces the new Server Monitor and Multiserver Monitor. By providing information about the server — including requests, queries, memory usage, and errors — the Server Monitor allows you to troubleshoot and fine-tune applications in development and in production. You can also set alerts and other actions to help prevent memory problems, slow pages, or other issues that would negatively impact a user's experience with the application.

PDF features

ColdFusion 8 applications can dynamically generate and interact with PDF documents and forms for a printable, portable way to intelligently capture and share information.

Ajax features

ColdFusion 8 can easily provide data to existing Ajax applications and frameworks. You can use simple tags to access a large library of prebuilt Ajax user interface components such as rich text editors, data grids, tree controls, tab navigators, and more.

.NET integration

With ColdFusion 8, you can specify any .NET object — either local or remote — and use it in your ColdFusion application, just like any Java™ or other object resource.

Microsoft Exchange Server integration

ColdFusion 8 applications can programmatically access Exchange Server functionality such as calendars, tasks, and contacts.

Interactive debugger

User-based Administrator and RDS access

ColdFusion 8 allows you to create multiple ColdFusion Administrator and Remote Development Services (RDS) accounts with individual permissions, so you can tailor Administrator and RDS access to fit your specific security needs. Database interaction improvements

Plus, there is expanded database driver support with new options for SQL Server 2005, Oracle 10g, Sybase ASE15, MySQL 4 and 5, PostgreSQL 8, and others.

Argument collections

ColdFusion 8 makes it much simpler to code tags with many attributes. You can now specify an argumentsCollection attribute in most tags to specify the tag's attributes in a single structure.

Array and structure creation improvements

ColdFusion 8 allows you to create arrays and structures implicitly in assignment statements without using the ArrayNew or Structnew functions. The result is cleaner code with less typing.

Expanded platform, OS, and database support

ColdFusion 8 offers broad platform support with notable additions of Mac OS X on Intel®, JBoss, 64-bit support on Solaris™, JDK 1.5 and JDK 1.6, and support for VMware and Microsoft Virtual Server.

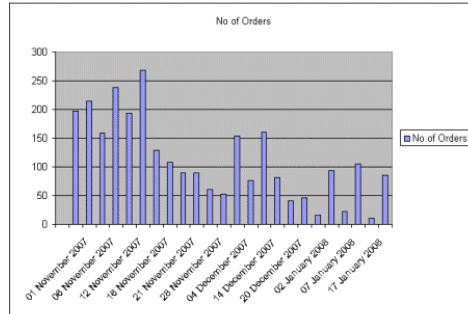
